

Checklist: Required documents for WUR PhD-application

Depending on the type (country of origin) of MSc diploma scans of the documents in the table below need to be uploaded by the PhD candidate into their own Hora Finita database account. You can use this checklist to see if you have collected all the required documents.

Note:

- All scans must be PDF files.
- Number the documents, see table below.
- Give all scans appropriate names like: *number-type of document-yourname.PDF*
- Reduce the file size of the scans if the complete set of scans exceeds 5 MB.
