Postdoctoral Researcher (m/f/d)

in full time.

Remuneration will be paid up to pay grade 13 TV-L depending on the tasks assigned and fulfilment of personal requirements.

Tasks:

- Investigating the functional conservation of ELF3 within the Brassicacea within the project "From model species to crops -ELF3 as a tool for crop acclimation to elevated ambient temperature" that is embedded in the EU-funded research consortium "Value Plant".
- Cloning and molecular characterization of ELF3 from diverse Brassicaceae (in vitro protein expression, in vitro and in vivo protein-protein interaction assays, etc.)
- Generation and characterization of CRISPR/Cas mutants in selected Brassicaceae
- Complementation of Arabidopsis mutants and phenotypic characterization
- Presentation and publication of scientific data

Requirements:

- An excellent university degree (or equivalent) in biology or biochemistry, molecular crop sciences or equivalent subject
- PhD in Plant biology, Molecular Biology, Biochemistry, Molecular Crop Science or related field
- A strong interest and experience in plant molecular biology and protein analyses
- Skills in statistics and R are advantageous
- Excellent English language skills (written and spoken)
- Ability to work independently and high motivation to work in a cooperative manner within the research consortium
